The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) in Pakistan, is looking for potential suppliers for the aforementioned items.

Suppliers interested in providing the items to UNICEF should register in UNGM at Basic and Level 1 levels of registration: <https://www.ungm.org/Account/Registration>.

Please note the following:

- Suppliers are not charged to register in UNGM.
- UNICEF does not contract with suppliers who are non-compliant with the National Labour Laws and Regulations and with those who do not abide to ethical standards related to child labour and landmines.
- UNICEF payment terms are after delivery.
- UNICEF prefers to collaborate with manufactures and with those who have previous working experience with either UN or International Organizations;
- Upon registration in UNGM and notification of the same to the relevant UNICEF official by the supplier, UNICEF officials may visit the premises of the supplier.

Existing suppliers of these items also to submit the Form. Any supplier not meeting the requirements or not properly filling the Form and attaching supporting documents will not be considered.

In order to be considered as a potential supplier, interested suppliers should submit their Expression of Interest including the following information. Additional verification of any information submitted may be requested

- Evidence of registration and license to operate in Pakistan
- Minimum of 2 years' experience in supplying similar items. Preference will be given to manufacturers.
- Specifications of the product you can offer.
- Certifications (if any) for the offered products
- Copy of the highest value contracts executed in the last 2 years
- Demonstrate financial stability and available credit line



Duly completed Form together with all relevant supporting documents should be sent through courier (not by hand) to UNICEF Pakistan Country Office, Diplomatic Enclave, Street 5, Sector G5, Islamabad. The envelope should be marked **“Expression of Interest for Supply”**.

The deadline for the receipt of fully completed form is 1800 hrs on 22 November 2020 . To facilitate submission of EOI through emails, all required documents can be sent to procurementpakistan@unicef.org
