

# **Q& A to bidders clarifications request**

	Question	Answers
1	Would the UN please provide us with the estimated travel times and distances for each route specified in Form C Technical Quotation Form?	Travel times are usually between 06:30 in the morning until 18:30 in the evening. The distance covered would be within Juba City boundaries including Gumbo Sherikat and Kapuri
2	Accounting for the number of passengers as well as pick up and drop off times provided by the UN, we estimate that at least four motorbikes will be required to perform these tasks. Would the UN please clarify how many motorbikes are currently being used? If there are no existing operations, how many motorbikes are anticipated?	The number of trips anticipated per day are 6 trips/ day on a normal scale, subject to additional trips that might occur randomly.
3	Form B Price Schedule Form specifies the expected number of trips per day is nine. However, Form C Technical Quotation Form specifies seven trips are required per day Monday through Thursday and six on Friday. Would the UN please clarify the expected number of trips per day?	The number of trips anticipated per day are 6 trips/ day on a normal scale, subject to additional trips that might occur randomly.
4	Form B Price Schedule Form specifies the UN is seeking price per trip and total price for trips, listing the quantity of motorbikes as one. Is it the UN's intention to receive price per motorbike or is the intention to use the price per motorbike as a multiplier against the total number of trips per day?	The price / motorbike is usually uniform, the aim is to use the price as a multiplier to the amount of trips used during day/week/month as we are aware that some trips destinations might be longer/shorter than others. we require a standard price/trip and then multiply it as such
5	Form C Technical Quotation Form specifies that "there may be up to 4 additional requirements during weekends & weekdays." Are these ad hoc trips intended to be priced at the same price per trip provided for the existing routes or on a trip-by-trip basis? If the former, would the UN please provide prospective routes as well as estimated travel times and distances?	the additional trips are the same as normal trips just out of the normal routes but the same in nature in price . the routes will be between Lemon Gaba and Gumbo sherikat ( Juba City Boundaries)
6	Would the UN please provide us with its requirements for the specifications of the motorcycles, if any?	Normal motorcycles operating in Juba as Taxi, is able to carry 1x driver & 1 passenger comfortably, with all electric indicators operating and mirrors , with all documents valid and permits to operate within South Sudan and abiding by south sudan laws, driver needs to have valid driving license and motorbike needs to have valid logbook indicating public transport license
7	Do we have to provide helmets for each passenger?	Desirable but not required, the driver however needs to have one
8	Does the UN have any specific insurance requirements? If yes, please clarify the requirements for the scope of coverage.	Comprehensive insurance will suffice , although UN Staff are covered and insured
9	What is the transition timeframe from award to contract start?	1-July 2021
10	Form D Experience Form" is listed as a mandatory attachment in the Vendor Submission Document Checklist section on the UNOPS online portal. However, this form is not part of Section III Returnable Bidding Schedules. Does the UN require this form? If so, would you please provide us with a copy of it.	Form D is required refer to the last page of section III
11	What kind of motorbike can suitable for this service	Motorbikes that are used in Juba as taxi preferably not larger then 250cc, cable of transporting 2 pax comfortably for transportation and commercial purposes
12	Is it recommended for us to provide two or more motorbike when awarded the offer.	it is recommended to provide sufficient motobike number equivalent to the number of trips, especially when the trips usually start around the same time in each leg of the day
