1	<p>in item 7 and numeral 3, it is indicated to include: "Details of (in-house or external) datasets to be utilized for this assignment". What type of data does this indication refer to?</p>	<p>Bidders who conduct their own trend or risk analysis may wish to use their own datasets for the identification of swans and signals, but this is not a pre-requisite. It is, however, important that bidders provide an indication of the types of datasets that they are likely to utilize for their analysis.</p>
2	<p>the Request for Proposal for Services document indicates the existence of a fine and pecuniary penalty clause in the Part IV Requirements and numeral 3 Liquidated Damages. Considering that the bidder is a public entity, it is not possible that the effectiveness of the pecuniary penal clause be declared and imposed unilaterally and in full law. We would like to ask if this clause may be eliminated taking into account the nature of the proposing entity?</p>	<p>Bidders may request for modification or elimination of a particular clause in the UNICEF contractual provision of General Terms and Conditions, however, such requests will have to be reviewed by the legal office and could influence the award decision and/or result in significant delays to the contract issuance date without necessarily yielding to the request.</p>
