1.	Page 4, Section 6 Instructions	There are 4 application cut dates, is it possible to apply more than once, or at least update the application after your feedback?	A single expression of interest would be expected per company, although there is no rule that prevents the submission of another EOI at a later stage. If there is additional information not yet available that will add value to the proposal, it would be advisable to wait before submitting an EOI later in the year.
2	Page 4, Section 5 Eligibility & Qualification Criteria	Is there any interaction (interview, presentation, etc.) in the selection process?	Potential partners meeting the EOI criteria will be invited to interact with ATscale before submitting a more detailed proposal.
3	Page 4, Section 5 Eligibility & Qualification Criteria	How many companies would you consider partnering up with for each component (socket, foot)?	There is no target number of companies. We will consider each potential companies' proposals and we will move ahead with as many as are deemed compliant with the requirements set both at the initial EOI and the RFP.
4	Page 4, Section 6 Instructions	After submitting the EOI, how long would we have in between before submitting a full proposal?	We would anticipate that a proposal should be submitted within 3 months of being notified that a supplier has passed the EOI, although this may be extended based on the discussions with the potential partners.
5	Page 4, Section 6 Instructions	Would everyone be called at the same time (end of the year) or would you be receiving full applications throughout the year?	We will be receiving proposals throughout the year, following the EOI review periods.
