The UNESCO Institute for Statistics hereby invites qualified companies to submit sealed tenders as follows:

The Education 2030 Incheon Declaration and Framework for Action specifies that the mandate of the UIS is to be 'the mechanism for monitoring and reporting on SDG 4 and on education in the other SDGs' with the responsibility to 'report on the implementation of national and international strategies to help hold all relevant partners to account for their commitments as part of the overall SDG follow-up and review'. As part of this mandate, in 2016 the UIS established the Technical Cooperation Group on SDG 4 indicators (TCG) - Education 2030 (TCG) to provide a platform to discuss and develop the indicators used to monitor the Education 2030 Agenda in an open, inclusive and transparent manner.

Following a decision of the TCG, the UNESCO Institute for Statistics, in collaboration with the Global Education Monitoring Report, is therefore working on establishing the Education Statistical Commission and organising its First (Inaugural) Conference in February 2024 in Paris, France.

With this RFP, UIS seeks to identify a company to provide logistical support to the Conference including, but not limited to:

- 1. Travel support and hotel booking in Paris, France*
- 2. Organizing transportation in Paris, France.*

The purpose of this notice is to provide general information on the requirements for the procurement process and to inform interested suppliers how to obtain a copy of the Solicitation Documents.
