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### **ADB's Modern Procurement System (CMS2)**

1. The Asian Development Bank (ADB), a multilateral development finance institution headquartered in Manila, Philippines, wishes to receive technical and financial proposals from qualified firms for ADB's Modern Procurement System (CMS2).

2. The Instructions to Bidders included in this invitation are available or may be downloaded until 10 July 2024.

3. The Scope of Work is divided into four major components. Bidders have the option to implement one or more of these components based on their capabilities and the project requirements. The components are as follows:

- (i) CMS2 Platform
- (ii) System Implementation for CMS2
- (iii) User Portal for CMS2
- (v) AI Solution for CMS2

3. Qualified firms should possess the following qualifications.

- (i) Have the nationality of the eligible country in accordance with the List of ADB Eligible Member Countries. A Bidder shall be deemed to have the nationality of a Member Country if it is constituted, or incorporated, and operates in conformity with the provisions of the laws of that country;
- (ii) Have an independent legal existence as a valid registered company for at least five (5) years;
- (iii) Have a sound financial and credit position for the past two years. As a minimum, the Bidders net worth/total equity, calculated as the difference between total assets and total liabilities, should be positive;
- (iv) Have not been sanctioned nor be ineligible to enter into transactions with ADB or any other multilateral development bank or institution; and
- (v) Past performance of services at ADB (if applicable) will be taken into consideration as part of the bid evaluation.

5. A Bid Bulletin containing the responses shall be issued, responding to all written clarifications and all inquiries.

6. Bids should be submitted in the ADB e-procurement system in accordance with paragraph 17 of the Instruction to Bidders and should reach ADB electronically not later than **5:00 p.m. (Manila time) on 10 July 2024** through the eProc System, attention to: Procurement and Contracts Administration. Late bids will be rejected by ADB.

7. The selected Contractor shall be required to register with ADB's Supplier Registry before a recommendation to award the contract may be made.

8. ADB reserves the right to accept or reject any bid, and to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to award of Contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected Bidder or Bidders of the grounds for ADB's action.

9. This Invitation does not entail any commitment on the part of ADB, either financial or otherwise. All costs associated with the preparation and submission of the Bid shall be borne solely by the Bidder.
