

Questions UNFPA/MOZ/ITB/17/008

a) Delivery Schedule

- 1. Delivery Schedule from date of contract is indicated with 21 days. You allow international bidders to quote – but due to the volume it has to be shipped by sea. If you want the goods at site within 21 days only – it is not possible. So please confirm that 21 days mean the date where the goods should be available at FCA point**

This project is conducted with very tight deadline. The delivery days are provided DAP (Matola, Maputo-Province/Mozambique, Armazéns RJM, EN4, Bairro Tchumene, Parcela 3380/26) basis. The bidders are permitted to submit proposals based on both sea and air freight and the best possible delivery term that can be offered. UNFPA will make the final decision taking all relevant factors in to consideration including total cost and the delivery lead-times.

- 2. Delivery Schedule is 21 Calendar days from Date of Contract, kindly confirm whether the mode of transport to be offered is air transport**

- 3. The delivery time is 21 days from date of Contract. Is it possible to have longer period of time? Cardboard boxes would be loaded in 21 containers**

Please refer the answer above. This project is implemented with very tight deadlines and therefore we are not in a position to extend the lead-time.

- 4. As to the "delivery Schedule from date of contract" is 21 calendar days, does 21calendar days including shipping time? as it will be difficultly for international supplier if including the shipping time**

- 5. As per 2.2 schedule of requirements. in Section II, the lead time for International suppliers should be within 21 calendar days after receipt Contract. Is this delivery time mandatory? Do you accept a delivery time of 65 days for DAP terms to Mozambique? We need 45 days by Sea and 20 days for production.**

- 6. Due to Chinese holiday, we would like to ask for permission for a delayed delivery of samples. Could you accept that the sample arrive on 14th April**

This is unfortunately not possible, due to the tight deadline

- 7. Our forwarders do not have services to Mapola. Is it possible to offer CFR-Maputo Port instead DAP-MAPOLO?**

This is unfortunately not possible. Delivery has to be effected under Incoterm DAP-Matola

b) Samples

- 8. Regarding the samples, I would need a contact person and a telephone number in order to ship the samples.**

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- 9. Kindly advise contact person details for samples to be submitted.**

- 10. Could you please also advise a more detailed address (ATTN / PHONE NUMBER / POST CODE) since we need to provide this to our courier?**

- 11. Is it possible to send samples of products of different measures just for your reference? It is difficult to send samples of the requested products with the exact requested measures.**

Yes, this is acceptable

c) Specifications and Price

- 12. In Price Schedule there is a table for Services Import customs and clearance Import duties and taxes. Please confirm that UNFPA is exempted from taxis and duties, so that no costs have to be filled in.**

The government as Consignee is exempted of taxes and import duties.

- 13. Lot number 1 – Carton boxes and Archive boxes: Please advise if you would like your boxes to be glued or only stapled. Taking into consideration the humidity in Mozambique staples may get rusted in a short period of time, kindly advise how the box should be joined.**

The boxes are preferably glued, but we accept both.

- 14. Lot number 2 – Item 3 and 4: The size of the plastic bags, are they measured in centimetres or millimetres? On your request you mention mm which makes the bag very small.**

There is an error in the specifications indeed. The size has to be measured in centimetres

- 15. Please advise on the Micron (thickness) of the plastic bags for item 3 and 4.**

Micron: 100 minimum

- 16. Lot number 2 – Item 5: Plastic bags “Manga” Please advise on the micron (thickness) that this bag should be made in and kindly reconfirm the size of the bag 100cmL (top width) x 70cm (bottom width) x 100cmH.**

Micron: 60 minimum; The Sizes are correct, please note, that the bottom is folded/bended

- 17. May we request for clearer pictures or 3D drawings of the manga bag to observe the dimensions and seal.**

See Photo below, the headfirst Manga bag, with a folded and bended bottom in both sides. The Photos are submitted by the partner, so it is not possible to get a more detailed one soon.

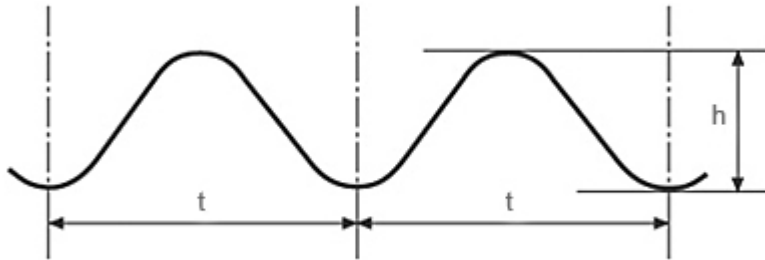


- 18. For the Technical Specification of "Archive Boxes" product, can you show us more pictures ,as from the existing picture ,we don't know the way how it open ?**

The Photos are submitted by the partner, so it is not possible to get a more detailed one soon. There are different options acceptable. The Archive Boxes need a fixed cover, which is closable and the cover is preferably to be inserted on the side.

- 19. Also can you explain what does it mean about the specification:Cardboard type "C"5mm ? does it means the thickness should be 5mm ?**

“c” is a standardized flute type:



Flute type C: t: 6,5-7,9 mm, h: 3,1-4,0 mm

20. Do you accept that we provide FCA port in China price?

Suppliers should be able to deliver the goods to the end destination based on the incoterm mentioned in the ITB document.

21. Plastic Bag 1, Plastic Bag 2 and Plastic Bag “Manga”: How many microns (µm) is required for these products?

Please refer to answers under questions 15 and 16

22. Plastic Bag 1 and Plastic Bag 2: the measures in the documents are in mm, I think you mean “cm”. Please kindly confirm.

23. Plastic Bag “Manga”: How many units do you require? 70.000 units (as page 16) or 60.000 unites (as the rest of the documents).

60,000 units

24. Plastic Bag 1: Is the colour relevant? Green or Transparent

The colour is not relevant, but preferably transparent

25. Regarding Technical specifications: For item 22, the Chalk. It is said quantity 150,000 EACH, please clarify how many quantity in a box? Do you accept 100 each in a box?

This is unrelated to this ITB. For ITB for Stationery: It is acceptable, if the quantity is the same.

26. Please see below clarification for Line Item# 2 & 3:

a) Please provide Thickness of the Bag

b) Kindly clarify and confirm the Size of the bag, the size which mentioned in mm is very small, for ex:- line item# 2: 41mm x 28mm would be 4.1cm x 2.8cm only
