I. DESCRIPTION OF REQUIREMENTS

UN WFP Somalia, has its Liaison Offices in Nairobi and is currently operational in Somaliland, Puntland, Central, Banadir and South regions of Somalia with its Country Office in Mogadishu and Area Offices established in Hargeisa, Bossaso, Galkayo, Mogadishu and Dollow.

The World Food Programme (WFP) Somalia Country Office has supported the development of logistics capacity building in Somalia through and rehabilitation projects in Mogadishu and Bossaso and is currently engaged in improvements to be made to the Kismayo port. The Port of Kismayo, lies on the north east corner of Qooriga Kismayo (Kismayo Bay) in south Somalia about 60 miles north of the Kenyan border and located to the south of Mogadishu.

Kismayo Bay is accessible at all seasons and provides shelter to vessels of moderate draught. Vessels of shallow or medium draught may obtain sheltered anchorage in the south west part of the bay in depths of 6 to 7 M, sand and mud with good holding. This provides the best shelter during the strength of SW monsoon. Further anchorages are available in the Port of Kismayo. The Port of Kismayo is formed by an "L" shaped breakwater extending south-westwards from Seerbeenti Island and then arming out westwards to form a sheltered harbour. Vessels with drafts up to about 8 meters can be accommodated either alongside or at anchorage in the port depending on the state of the tide. Two RO/RO ramps are available for use on the main jetty.

UNWFP Somalia hereby seeks to pre-qualify reliable contractors with experience and capacity to carry out Wreck Removal in Kismayo Port-Somalia. Reputable Contractors are encouraged to fill in the attached supplier registration form which can also be requested by e-mail from Somalia.Procurement@wfp.org or at the Liaison Office, on UN Crescent, Off UN Avenue, Gigiri Nairobi.

Eligible contractors, who meet all of the pre-qualification criteria in this EOI, may be invited to the Request for Proposal (RFP). The invitation will be open to any contractors who are able to give the services described above.

No Commitment: This EOI does not contain a contractual offer of any kind. Any Proposal submitted will be regarded solely as a Proposal and not as an acceptance by the Proposer to any offer made by WFP. No contractual relationship will exist except pursuant to an AGREEMENT signed by WFP and the selected Proposer(s) after the Tender Solicitation process. This EOI does not commit WFP to consider any Proposal or award a contract.



Terms of Reference and more details of requirements will be sent to the qualified prospective bidders who will have expressed their interest in the submission of bids.

II. SPECIFIC INFORMATION

Prerequisites for eligibility are as follows:

All companies are required to complete the **Supplier registration form** and submit it along with the following documents;

- 1. Documentation showing that your company has been in existence for the last 3 years or more,**
- 2. Financial capability – three years audited accounts/Bank statements**
- 3. Legal capacity – certificate of incorporation/registration**
- 4. Past performance – copies of 3 recent Purchase orders of contracts from your clients for carrying out similar works to that described in this Expression of Interest**
- 5. Company profile illustrating: structure and history of company; presence and experience in Somalia.**
- 6. Name of areas where your business is located.**

For Registered Vendors:

- a. Vendors already registered must ensure that the information and documentation (e.g., financial statements, address, contact name, etc.) provided in connection with their registration are up to date.
- b. Your company (both parent and/or subsidiaries, if applicable) is not currently removed, invalidated or suspended by the UN Headquarters, field missions or other UN organizations(including the World Bank) and is not under investigation by a government or UN Member State.
- c. Your company (both parent and/or subsidiaries, if applicable) is not on, or associated with a company or individual on the 1267 List and 1844 List. - d. You have no outstanding bankruptcy, judgment or pending legal action that could impair operating as a *going concern*.
- e. Your subsidiaries, agents, intermediaries and principals agree to cooperate with the United Nations Office of Internal Oversight Service during any investigative processes undertaken by them, either before during or after execution of a contract, including providing all required documents, company records, access to employees, officers and staff, as well as financial information.
- f. A copy of the Potential Bidder's Company Profile and organizational structure denoting prior experience in this field.

For companies not yet registered with WFP

You are still invited to participate in this EOI considering all the conditions above, except please note that in order to be eligible for UN registration, your company must provide the following before the award of the contract in case your bid is competitive:

- a. A comprehensive list of services that can be provided by your company.



- b. A list of names and addresses of agents and subcontractors that may be used in the performance of any resulting contract.
- c. A list of all senior management staff that will be responsible for executing any resulting contract, including their professional experience, level of training and skills, and current managerial responsibilities and financial authorities.
- d. A complete set of Financial Statements for the Past 3 years: Audited Accounts i.e. Balance Sheet, Income Statement, etc.
- e. Duly completed WFP Supplier Registration Form attached to be sent to the above email addresses.
