- (b) Past 3 (three) years financial statements to demonstrate the soundness of the bidder's financial position and its prospective long term profitability including the capacity to have a cash flow amount of USD 30,000.00 in Mogadishu, Somalia.
- (c) Average annual construction turnover not less than USD 100,000.00 during the last three years in Mogadishu, Somalia.
- (d) Satisfactory completion of at least 1 (one) civil construction and electrical works worth USD 80,000 (US Eighty Thousand) in Mogadishu, Somalia over the last five (5) years.
- (e) List of equipment available in Mogadishu for the construction works (indicating if these are owned or leased).
- (f) List of personnel available for the construction works (number of personnel, their professional qualifications and job categories required).
- (g) Ability to undertake works in Mogadishu, Somalia without sub-contracting along with current contract commitments.
- (h) The bidder must not have any pending disputes or litigation.
- (i) The bidder must not be under UN embargo
