## About the UNGM

The United Nations Global Marketplace – UNGM – is the **common vendor database for the UN system**.

It brings together **UN procurement staff** and the **vendor community**.

Registration on UNGM is a **requirement to participate in tenders** from more and more UN organizations.

**All companies** are welcome to register on UNGM. **Individual consultants** are also able to register.



## What are the benefits?

Registration on UNGM is **free of charge**.

Vendors can register with **29 UN organizations** which use UNGM to source vendors.

These organizations account for **99% of the total annual UN procurement spend**.

Vendors have access to a large amount of information including **business opportunities**.

UNGM provides an excellent **opportunity** to introduce your products and services to many UN organizations, countries and regions by only completing **one on-line registration form**.



## How do I register?

It takes approximately **5 to 10 minutes** to complete the Basic level registration.

1. **Create an account** at [www.ungm.org](http://www.ungm.org)
2. **Complete the registration form** and automatically register with the UN organizations matching your vendor's profile

The website is available in **multiple languages**.

## Where can I find business opportunities?

Vendors can access business opportunities **free of charge** on the UNGM website.

Procurement notices are published on UNGM by more than **40 UN organizations and entities**.

You can find around **500 active notices** at any one time.



## Subscribe to the Tender Alert Service

Subscribe to the Tender Alert Service (TAS) and receive the latest and most relevant business opportunities **by email**. You can also add colleagues as contacts.

The Tender Alert Service is an optional value-added service for which a nominal fee of USD250 per year is charged.
